Plot Breakdown:

A comical feast that embraces the wackiness in every family, featuring an original story and it's every father's nightmare: Wednesday Addams, the ultimate princess of darkness, has grown up and fallen in love with a sweet, smart young man from a respectable family – a man her parents have never met. And if that wasn't upsetting enough, Wednesday confides in her father and begs him not to tell her mother. Now, Gomez Addams must do something he's never done before – keep a secret from his beloved wife, Morticia. Everything will change for the whole family on the fateful night they host a dinner for Wednesday's "normal" boyfriend and his parents.

Themes:


- Individuality and Acceptance: A prominent theme in the musical is the celebration of individuality and the acceptance of one's unique qualities. The Addams family embraces their eccentricities, dark humor, and unconventional lifestyle, teaching the audience that it's essential to be true to oneself and accept others for who they are.

The musical highlights the strength of familial connections, emphasizing that family is not defined solely by blood but by the love and acceptance shared among its members.

Themes:


Setting:

The show opens up on the family graveyard, in which the family tree, a giant Spanish Oak, overhangs. I imagine the tree being SR, sitting just behind the main curtain. The tree will be the thematic focal point of the show, extending all the way up above the border curtain, and with



Setting:

The main set will be a fixed unit set with varying levels entrances, and will represent both the exterior and interior of the house. The Addams Family home should be representational of the Victorian Gothic style, with Spanish flares represented throughout.



Scenic Design:

The scenic design itself should be that of expressionism, with many of the edges being curved and angled. The colors should be dark (grays and black mostly), and walls should be painted to look as stone. The scenery will be that of a fixed unit set, with levels, steps, and multiple entrances. There will be other pieces that will move on and off to represent different locations.



Lighting and Effects:

The lighting will be very dim throughout, with lots of practical lighting throughout the set with the use of battery operated candles. I imagine using a projector on the cyc to project a a background image (spooky trees/graveyard and a moon). There will also be fog used throughout the


show, primarily in the opening number.



Gomez Addams

Male, Bb4-G5

A man of ambiguous Spanish decent who takes great pride in his family and revels all it means to be an "Addams". Smart, comedic actor with tenor vocals.

Morticia Addams

Female, G3-Bb5

The strength of the family; a strong comedic actress with dry wit. A strong dancer/mover with alto/mezzo soprano vocals.

Wednesday Addams

Female, A4-E5

A strong girl who has the same dry wit and sensibility as her mother.

Strong pop belt vocals.

Lucas Beineke

Male, C4-B5

Young man who falls in love with Wednesday and plans to marry her.

Contemporary pop vocals.

Pugsley Addams

Male/Female, A4-F5

Young actor who plays 12 years old. Strong, high vocals that have not yet changed.

Grandma Addams

Female, G4-F5

Feisty, fun, and quirky comedic actress with strong character vocals.

Uncle Fester

Male/Female, C4-B5

The androgynous family member who serve's as the show's narrator. A vaudeville style comedian with tenor vocals.

Lurch

Male, Eb2-E4

A very tall character actor with low bass voice. He speaks in moans and groans.

Mal Beineke

Male, C4-A5

Stuffy father of Lucas and husband to Alice. Serious actor with high baritone/tenor vocals.

Alice Beineke

Female, Ab4-G#5

Mother to Lucas and wife to Mal. Comedic actress with soprano/belt vocals.

Ancestors

Male and Female

Ensemble singer/dancers. Represent various decades and centuries of Addams family members past.
